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POST-TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR:

ACCURE

General Information:

A topical anesthetic will be applied to the areas of your face to be treated

You will have the option of using nitrous oxide (a gas that can help relax you during the treatment)

You will wear special glasses during the procedure to protect your eyes

The device will cool your skin by blowing cool air on your skin

The handpiece of the laser will touch your skin and move slowly over the area to be treated

POST PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS:

You may continue to use your routine facial products, such as cleansers, lotions, make-up, and any topical facial treatments you were using at home before the treatment.

No special precautions need to be taken following the treatment

Apply an SPF daily to protect your skin from excess sun

You may use cold compresses or cold packs to soothe the skin after treatment

We do not expect any adverse effects from this treatment; however, you may (although rare) experience the following:

Swelling

Possible inflammatory papules/pustules can present within 20-30 minutes after treatment and up to 48 hours after treatment. This usually resolves within a week

Short-term acne flare-ups are common post-treatment and usually resolve within one week

Dryness and scaling of the skin

Itching, stinging, burning sensation

Discoloration of the skin

Blistering, Burn, pitting

Pain and/or discomfort
