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POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS FOR:

FRAXEL™ RE: PAIR, ERBIUM / ABLATIVE

What should I expect after my treatment?

Post-treatment care and follow-up visits are essential to the healing process. The treated area may turn very red and swollen. Swelling may last for seven (7) days or longer, and some patients experience redness for up to one (1) month or longer. You may also experience oozing, discomfort, some bleeding, bruising, and crusting of the treated area. You may experience skin peeling on days 3-5, depending on the treatment technique used. Post-treatment healing varies from patient to patient.

What should I do to the treated area after my treatment?

Apply Alastin Skin Nectar & Alastin Soothe & Protect (in that order) in the A.M. and P.M. and as often as needed to keep the area moist. Soak the area with cool water four (4) times a day and reapply the Skin Nectar and Soothe & Protect (in that order) each time. You do not have to soak the area at night while you sleep. You may begin to use Alastin Gentle Cleanser and /or Cetaphil Cleanser twenty-four (24) hours after your treatment. You may shower and wash your hair. Gently dab areas of crusting and bleeding with a moist gauze, pat dry, and apply the Alastin products. Always keep the treated area moist to ensure proper healing. Sleep with your head elevated. This will help with swelling. Take Tylenol, as needed, **for discomfort only.**

- DO NOT:** Pick your skin
- DO NOT:** Wear sunscreen or make-up until you have received physician approval
- DO NOT:** Use abrasive cleansers or exfoliate your skin for at least four (4) weeks following your treatment.
- AVOID:** Direct contact with pets.

Schedule a follow-up appointment for the day after your treatment. You may be

required to see your physician several times following your procedure, depending
on the healing process
