What should I expect after my treatment?

The treated area may become red, swollen and bruised. This redness, swelling and bruising may last for several days and rarely up to 2 weeks. The bruising may occur particularly around the jawline and below the eyes. "Tracking" (small pinpoint marks) from the needles may take one week to clear. You may also experience some tenderness and itching as well as dry patches of skin.

?What should I do to the treated area post procedure

We recommend you use the Alastin skin care products post-procedure kit.
.Alastin cleanser and skin nectar will be applied immediately after your treatment

May I wear make-up after my procedure?

Make-up may be worn the day following your procedure. Care must be taken to avoid irritation of the skin while removing your make-up. Avoid abrasive or irritating make-up removers and cleansers. Do not scrub your face.

May I be exposed to the sun following my procedure?

Your skin should always be protected from the sun. Direct exposure of sunlight should be avoided following your treatment. If there is no blistering or crusting, apply a sunscreen of SPF-30 or higher to the treated areas.

When should I return for further treatment?

Additional treatments vary from patient to patient. The staff will let you know when you should return for additional treatments, if recommended.
