POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS FOR:

LASEMD™ ULTRA

What should I expect after my treatment?

The treated area will turn slightly red and swollen. This redness and swelling may last for several days. After a few days, and depending upon the condition you had treated, you may experience many small black specks (peppery-like appearance) on the treated area. You may also experience some tenderness and itching, as well as dry patches of skin. This may last for several days.

What should I do to the treated area post-treatment?

Your skin should always be protected from the sun. Direct exposure to sunlight should be avoided following your treatment. Ice packs should be applied to the treated area for 15 minutes on and 15 minutes off until bedtime on the day of your procedure.

For Melasma and Post-Inflammatory Hyperpigmentation patients:

Following the instructions in "***What should I do to the treated area post-treatment,***" as well as the following: You will be provided with 2 bottles of 1mL depigmentation solution. Apply 1 bottle to the treated area upon returning home, and apply the 2nd bottle before bedtime.

?May I wear makeup following my procedure

Make-up may be applied four (4) hours following your procedure. Care must be taken to avoid skin irritation when removing makeup. You should avoid abrasive .or irritating makeup removers

May I be exposed to sunlight after my procedure?

Your skin should always be protected from the sun. Direct exposure to sunlight should be avoided following your treatment. We recommend applying a sunscreen of SPF 30 or higher to the treated area.

When should I return for further treatment?

Additional treatments vary from patient to patient. You will be informed if further treatment is recommended.
