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POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

VBEAM PRIMA, VBEAM PRO FOR REDNESS

What should I expect after my treatment?

Mild redness will occur after the procedure. On rare occasions, bruising can be seen. If the treated area is near the upper cheek or eye, you should anticipate some swelling. If this occurs, sleep with your head elevated. If crusting or blistering occurs, which is unlikely, the skin should be treated gently twice daily with Aquaphor Healing Ointment.

May I wear makeup after my procedure?

Make-up may be worn if there is no blistering or crusting following the procedure. Care must be taken to avoid skin irritation when removing makeup. You should avoid abrasive or irritating makeup removers and skin cleansers.

May I be exposed to sunlight after my procedure?

Your skin should always be protected from the sun. Direct exposure to sunlight should be avoided following your treatment. If there is no blistering or crusting, apply a sunscreen of SPF-30 or higher to the treated area for two (2) months following your treatment to avoid sun damage.

When should I return for further treatment?

Please make a follow-up appointment. Dr. Geronemus or his nurse will tell you when to return for your next treatment, if further treatment is recommended.
